

Toyonaka Tsubasa Park “ma-zika”

At this park, you can enjoy a close and comfortable view of airplanes just before landing from directly below, the side, and various other angles. Additionally, we have created an environment where visitors can stay for extended periods by offering food services and installing a large-roof plaza. In the future, we plan to gradually develop the area, including the adjacent Senrigawa embankment.

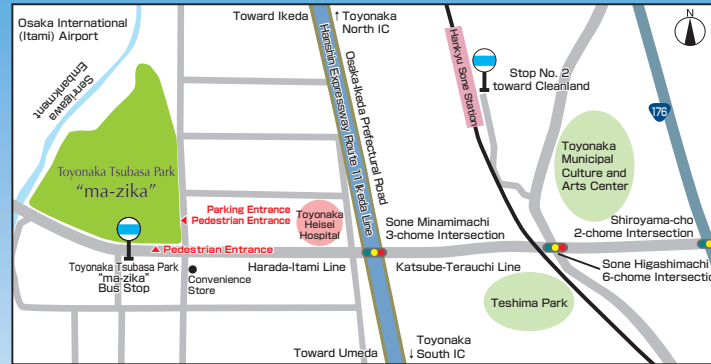


As this park is adjacent to Osaka International Airport, activities that could interfere with airport operations or aircraft safety are prohibited (and may be punishable by law).

Usage Guidelines

- Throwing objects at aircraft, shining penlights, flashlights, or laser pointers, and using radios or selfie sticks are all prohibited, as they may interfere with aircraft operations.
- The use of kites, balloons, drones, and radio-controlled aircraft that could potentially contact planes is prohibited.
- Do not enter the aviation lighting fenced area or dispose of trash there.
- Tents (including sunshades), tarps, or other items that could be blown away are not allowed.
- To prevent bird strikes, no trash bins are provided. Please take your garbage home and do not leave it behind.

● Visitors Using Public Transportation

Train: About 1.8 km on foot from Hankyu Takarazuka Line “Sone Station”
Share Cycle: From designated ports at Sone Station or Osaka International Airport to the dedicated port on the east side of the park
Bus: From Hankyu Bus “Hankyu Sone Station” Stop No. 2, take Route 95 bound for “Cleanland / Aeon Mall Itami,” and get off at “Toyonaka Tsubasa Park ‘ma-zika’ ”

● Visitors Arriving by Car

About 2.3 km from “Toyonaka North” exit or about 2.1 km from “Toyonaka South” exit on the Hanshin Expressway Route 11 Ikeda Line
About 400 meters west of the Sone Minamimachi 3-chome intersection on the Osaka-Ikeda Prefectural Road

One of Japan's top aircraft viewing spots, also known as a "sacred place for airplane photography." It is being developed together with this park.

Toward Itami City



① Learning Forest

An area planted with widely-used tree species to serve as reference for future planting.



② Commemorative Tree Grove

An area where citizens plant trees such as the fragrant olive tree, the city tree commemorating events like births and marriages.



③ Covered Observation Plaza

A plaza with a roof that offers views of the airport runway, planes, and the park without worrying about rain or sun.

④ Management Office

Also serves as an information center for the park. Equipped with restrooms and nursing rooms.



⑤ Dog Run

Separate areas for large/medium and small dogs, allowing pets and their owners to play safely and comfortably.

⑥ Observation & Lawn Plaza (BANK)

This plaza features a lawn and a structure called "BANK." From the pathway on top of the "BANK," visitors can enjoy a panoramic view of the airport runway and watch airplanes up close.
